Calling all Strings players in grades 6-9! Come join us for Festival Strings 2018!

Sponsored by the Ridgewood Symphony Orchestra, Festival Strings is an all-string orchestra of young musicians who come together for five intense rehearsals and a wonderful concert each winter. This year's concert will be at Benjamin Franklin Middle School, Ridgewood, NJ, on Saturday afternoon, **March 17**, **2018**.

The conductor for Festival Strings 2018 is once again Todd Van Beveren. Mr. Van Beveren is the founder and artistic director of the Northern NJ Youth Orchestra. He also conducts the Montclair Chamber Ensemble and is the Orchestra Director at Columbia High School.

To participate in this orchestra, students must be in grades 6-9 and must be recommended by their school orchestra **or** private music teacher, who agrees to help the student prepare the music. Abilities on their instruments must include a command of first position, with extensions and accidentals, and facility in the higher positions for more advanced sections of the orchestra.
